



Disability-related Health Supports

Did you know that from 1 October 2019, additional disability-related health supports are available to purchase using NDIS funding? The typical types of support available can be grouped into eight 'support type' categories.

“The additions will enable many more people to maintain their health and live in the community”. “We know that 50 young people with disabilities are admitted into aged care every week and these improvements to the NDIS will help people with disabilities to avoid being forced into aged care facilities because their disability-related health needs will finally be addressed by the NDIS”.

The following list of fundable supports is not exhaustive and supports may be delivered in a range of ways.

- Continence supports
- Diabetic management supports
- Dysphagia supports
- Epilepsy supports
- Nutrition supports
- Podiatry supports
- Respiratory supports
- Wound and pressure care supports
