



## **What is Short Term Accommodation used for?**

Short Term Accommodation (STA) is NDIS speak for respite accommodation – this allows both the carer and the person they care for to take a break. STA is support provided for a limited period of time, typically delivered in a group-based facility.

Short Term Accommodation funding now replaces what used to be called ‘respite’

### **Who can access Short Term Accommodation (STA)?**

Eligible NDIS participants can access STA for reasons such as:

- a change in circumstances, or a crisis situation that puts the person at risk of homelessness or being prematurely placed into an aged care facility
- to receive capacity building and/or independent living support
- for carers’ respite, if your carer has been hospitalised or if support staff are on leave
- if you are waiting for home modifications
