



Assistance with social & community participation, what is covered?

Assistance with Social and Community Participation is a funded support category that you may find in your NDIS plan, under **Core Supports**.

This funding covers supporting participants needs and to meet their goals relating to participating in community, social or recreational activities and help you to access your community for social and recreation activities either individually or in a group.

It can also support attending a centre-based program to develop skills that will help you to access the community independently.

Funding for this support does not cover expenses related to recreational pursuits, such as event tickets for the participant, and the cost of entry for a paid support worker to attend a social or recreational event.

Supports can include:

- developing life skills and getting involved with groups and activities that help you connect with other people and build your skills
- recreation and leisure activities
- personal interest activities like art, woodwork, beauty, cooking and volunteering
