



Prosthetics and Orthotics covered by the NDIS

The NDIS covers Podiatry services and devices. Podiatry can be accessed by participants who have therapy supports and/or assistive technology selected under their NDIS plan

The NDIA have developed an Assistive Technology General Prosthetics and Orthotics Assessment Template to assist providers to determine and compile the necessary information for the NDIA to determine if a proposed service (e.g. an orthotic or prosthetic service) meets the reasonable and necessary criteria (as required by section 34 of the NDIS Act 2013).

NDIA fund the full cost of a reasonable and necessary prosthetic/orthotic solution to address their need in line with the plan goals

Does the participant have choice and control over the components they want in their orthosis/prosthesis?

Custom made prosthetics and orthotics are level 3 or 4 in the NDIS AT Complexity Level Classification and thus a participant is required to seek professional advice in assessing and specifying a suitable solution that they want to fund through the NDIS participant plan.
